
Project Overview

Spirit by Jim Thompson restaurant is an homage to the legendary silk trader who established the world-famous silk brand and home furnishings brand some 67 years ago. The restaurant's furnishings are custom-made and make use of Jim Thompson silks and other textiles. The porcelain features a pattern called Shadows created by designer Paul Heredia who was moved by the shadows in the gardens of the Jim Thompson House. The interior was designed by Boiffils Studio.

The restaurant is set in a preserved lush green garden, with a covered patio space to offer guests a respite from the urban jungle of Bangkok.







The pivoting panels covered in silks from the Jim Thompson collection reveal or conceal different spaces in the dining room.





The interior woodwork, the warm décor, and the upholstery and silks from the designs of Jim Thompson all reflect the brand's eye for refined sophistication.





The floor-to-ceiling windows, the reflections of the stainless steel panels in the ceiling, the use of tropical woods, and the use of fragments of ceramic and stone, all enhance the ambiance.
