The new Pugliese restaurant is in Piazza De Angeli 1, Milan in the heart of the Marghera-De Angeli district. Il Mannarino is a real butcher's shop that turns into a restaurant with a kitchen and grill on sight. The restaurant has two floors and 65 seats. 
























Juventus Flagship Milan

Project Overview

Juventus has inaugurated the new Flagship Store in Milan in Corso Matteotti 8, one of the main shopping streets. This is the fifth store in Italy, and the Chief Revenue Officer, Giorgio Ricci said they will have an opening every year over the next five years. This flagship store has an exhibition space totaling 320 square meters on two floors, revisiting the Juventus identity on High Street and is represented in the industrial minimal design typical of the Juventus store. The winning cups are displayed in the center of the first floor, and the design and lighting are the main characters of the facade.
