
Project Overview

Treeline Urban Resort is a privately owned, 48-room design hotel on Siem Reap's Riverside in Cambodia, founded and built by architect Hok Kang. The resort's clean and functional style is combined with living artworks by leading Cambodian artists to reflect both a reverence for nature as well as show a new, modern side of Cambodia. The resort's curated experience includes dedicated spaces for a growing private collection of contemporary art.


Location map




The resort is within easy reach (7km) of UNESCO World Heritage site Angkor Wat in Siem Reap.

Treeline's most significant feature is its center courtyard, a communal tree-filled space that features a wraparound art gallery and a large cascading water feature.


